#### **RULES FOR TEAM SHIAI**

- A) Categories: Team kata & kumite White, Green, Brown & Black belt
- B) 3 persons per team. No limit to the number of teams representing any one dojo.

Teams may be coed, composed of men and/or women. i.e. women will compete against men in kumite events.

Note: If a womens kumite division is held, these will be for women only. However, women may still compete on coed kumite teams. For example, a black belt woman may compete on a womens kumite team as well as on a coed black belt kumite team.

- C) Age restriction is 6 years and up. Judges will use discretion when considering the possibility of injury.
- D) Lower ranking colored belts may be moved up (only one level) to complete a team, but not down. For example, green belts may compete on a brown belt team, but a brown belt may not compete on a green belt team.
- E) The same competitor may compete on more than one team\* or category

  (As long as "D" above is met). For example, it is possible for the same brown belt to compete in brown belt kata and kumite as well as in black belt kata and kumite.
  - \* With the exception of kumite in the same category.

    (For example, the same green belt may not compete on two green belt kumite teams, but may be a member of two different green belt kata teams)
- F) Judges: Club instructors and senior students who are not competing.
- G) Scoring: Same general criteria as Regional tournament
  - 1) Kata: Point system kata of choice for all teams
  - 2) Kumite: Flag system -
    - 9-7 kyu: Basic Three-step sparring (jodan, chudan punching technique)
    - 6-4 kyu: Basic One-step sparring (jodan, chudan, mae geri, kekomi geri)
    - 3-1 kyu: Basic Semi-free sparring (jodan, chudan, mae geri, kekomi, mawashi geri) or Free sparring if both competitors agree
    - DAN: Free sparring One point, 2 min. matches. NO CONTACT. Groin & mouth guards and fist covers are the only allowable protectors. Fist covers must be worn, and can be provided if necessary.
- \* Semi-free sparring if either contestant is under 18 years of age (unless both contestants, their parents, and their instructors wish to waive this safety precaution). Any match becomes semi-free if ANY CONTESTANT OF ANY GENDER OR AGE REQUESTS (at any time before the match begins) THAT THEY DO NOT WANT TO FREE SPAR.
